ADMISSION LETTER

RE: Haralampos Bravos D.O.B 01.12.2004

Patient Haralampos Bravos child of Dimirtios and Georgia with Social Security No. 0112041672, is suffering from Alveolar Liver Rhabdomyosarcoma and is due to be admitted to the Harley Street Clinic. The patient requires to be reviewed by our multidisciplinary paediatric, paedo-oncology, and paedo-radiology team under the care of Dr. Stergios Zacharoulis.

We have been informed that the patient does not have the approval from the Greek public insurance to be hospitalized abroad but the family wishes for the patient to be treated in London. It is not compliant with the hospitals policy to accept patients without some kind of insurance.

Therefore a deposit or a letter of guarantee for £210,000 will be required to be paid before or at the time of the admission to enable the patient to be admitted. During the hospitalization of the patient a credit balance of £60,000 should be available on the patients' account at all times. The above amount will serve as a guarantee.

For that reason is given the capability of transferring money from relatives, friends, nonprofit organizations, associations and also from anyone who would like to contribute to that cause, to the hospitals account. This money will be solely used for the hospitalization of the above named patient authorizing his mother to receive documents.
